The LED-based power failure lights are part of standard switches and receptacles and are made to fit in standard electrical wall boxes and cover with standard wall plates to match any room design. “This standardized approach allows power failure lighting to be installed in nearly any room of any home without the need for new wiring.” said Bob Barton, president of PowerSURE Corporation. “Severe storms are on the rise and with the increased risk of power failures we need a standardized solution that everyone can use. Our goal is to make these products recognized as ‘the standard’ in power failure lighting protection for residential living spaces.”

The safety lights can be made as stand-alone lighting devices, or built into standard light switches, dimmers and receptacles. This patented approach brings power failure lighting protection to any location without losing switch or receptacle functionality when and where it is needed. The products make great replacement devices because their standard size allows them to fit wherever standard devices install. The energy saving LED lighting can also provide night time illumination reducing the need to turn on main lights when it is dark.

“These are products that can be installed in hundreds of millions of locations, for new construction, repair and replacement, and renovation markets. They are an architect’s dream product because they can be specified without affecting a project’s design goals or room styling objectives.” said Barton.
